Deadlines

To be fully considered for financial aid and housing, the application priority deadline is February 1 for fall enrollment and November 15 for spring enrollment. Applications received after these dates will be reviewed on a space-available basis. We will begin reviewing your application once you have submitted all required documents.

Submit

Along with your application, you must provide:

- A copy of your high school transcript
- TOEFL or IELTS scores.

Optional

- SAT (code 3669) and/or ACT (code 4308) scores (Required for nursing majors)
- Résumé, personal essay, and letters of recommendation.
